Professor Vikram Deshpande joined the faculty of Engineering at the University of Cambridge as a lecturer in 2001 and was promoted to a professorship in Materials Engineering in 2010. He has also served on the faculties at the University of California, Santa Barbara and at the Technical University of Eindhoven. His work is primarily in experimental and theoretical solid mechanics. He serves on the editorial boards of a number of journals in mechanics and biomechanics including Journal of the Mechanics and Physics of Solids, Modelling and Simulation in Materials Science and Engineering and the Proceedings of the Royal Society, London. He has been awarded the Philip Leverhulme Prize, the William Hopkins medal, the 2020 Rodney Hill Prize in Solid Mechanics, the 2022 Warner T. Koiter Medal, the 2022 William Prager Medal, and elected Fellow of the Royal Society, London. He is also an ERC Advanced Grant awardee.

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
